Justin Alunni and Ryan Manley, have had an impressive two weeks of golf. The teammates at Lackawanna College have combined to finish first and second place in the teams last two golf matches to pace the falcons to their third consecutive GSAC conference win.

Justin Alunni has had past college golf success, qualifying for nationals in 2005. This season he has finished 10th, 1st, and 1st, in the teams first three matches of the 2006-2007 season.
