THE OURDASH SCHOLARSHIP

Description

The OurDash Scholarship was founded in conjunction with OurDash, Inc. It aims to support students who demonstrate a significant improvement in their high school record. In this way, it seeks to serve as an incentive and reward for high standards of academic performance.

Criteria

The OurDash Scholarship is awarded annually to two (2) applicants within the Scranton School District, one (1) from Scranton High School and one (1) from West Scranton High School. The student recipients will be first-year students at Lackawanna College who have shown a substantial academic improvement, as reflected by their GPA, within the frame of 9th to 12th grade.

Award

The OurDash Scholarship is awarded in the total amount of \$3500. The award is distributed twice annually, \$1750 during the fall semester and another \$1750 during the spring semester, to each participant.

Application Procedure

The student must submit the application to the Lackawanna College Admissions Office along with required materials by the application deadline. Selected students will be notified shortly after the deadline.

Application deadline for this scholarship is **April 30th**.
