**please ask yourself the following three questions:**

If you answer **YES** to any of these questions,  
**please do not come to campus.**

**Raise a flag in Starfish**, and the Pandemic Safety Team will contact you about your next steps, dates that you may be able to return to campus, and more. You should also directly contact your instructors through Starfish.

If you answer **NO** to all of these questions,  
**you may continue with normal activities once you feel better.**

You should also directly communicate with your instructors about any class absences that are unrelated to COVID-19. A Starfish flag does not need to be raised **unless you answer "YES"** to any of the above questions.
