FALCON FORWARD SCHOLARSHIP

Description

The **Falcon Forward Scholarship** is an annual, one-year scholarship designed in reflection of Lackawanna College's commitment to support incoming students who demonstrate both great potential and a desire to make a meaningful impact in their communities. This scholarship is awarded to assist the selected student(s) with college expenses and encourage both academic achievement and community involvement as they begin this next chapter of their college education.

Criteria

Scholarships are awarded annually to incoming undergraduate students, both first-time freshmen and transfer students. Candidates for this financial award should be seeking full-time or part-time enrollment in any of the College's bachelor's or associate degree programs and must remain in good academic standing. Based on need and availability of funds, returning students may apply again for this scholarship in future academic years.

Award

The amount of the award varies between \$1,000 - \$5,000 per academic year, based on need after financial aid (grants only) has been applied to the student's account. Funding is limited to tuition, fees, books, and supplies (as a direct cost). No refunds are available through this scholarship. This is a one-year (two-semester) scholarship as long as the student remains in good academic standing.

Application Procedure

Student must submit this scholarship application form, along with a 200-word personal statement (prompt below), to the Lackawanna College Office of Enrollment no later than the application deadline. All required college application materials must also be submitted and on file—the student must be eligible for college acceptance. A valid FAFSA listing Lackawanna College (school code 003283) should also be completed for the upcoming academic year. Selected students will be notified via email shortly after the deadline.

Deadline

Application deadline for this scholarship is **April 1st**.

- Must maintain full-time or part-time enrollment status and good academic standing,
