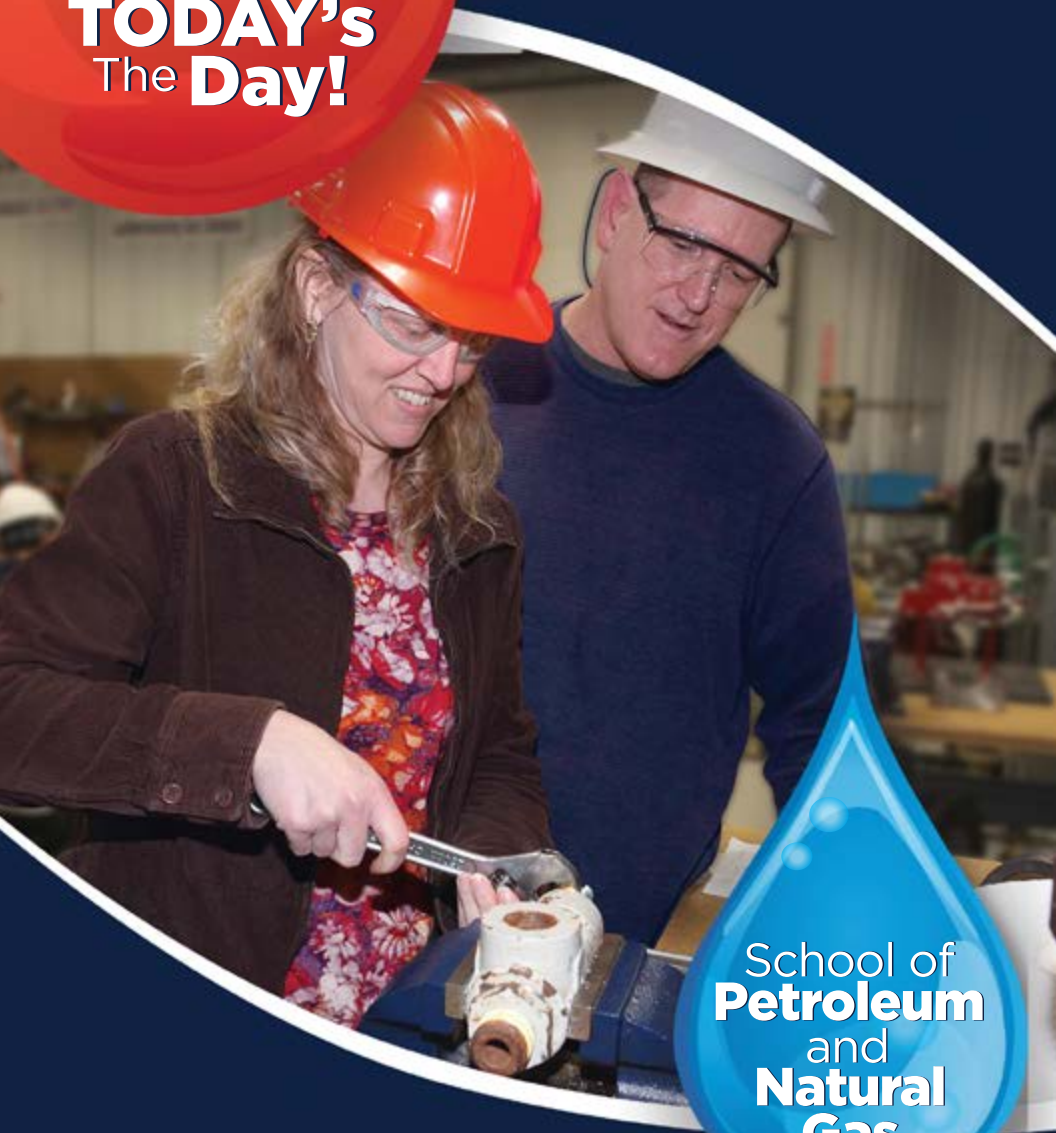

---

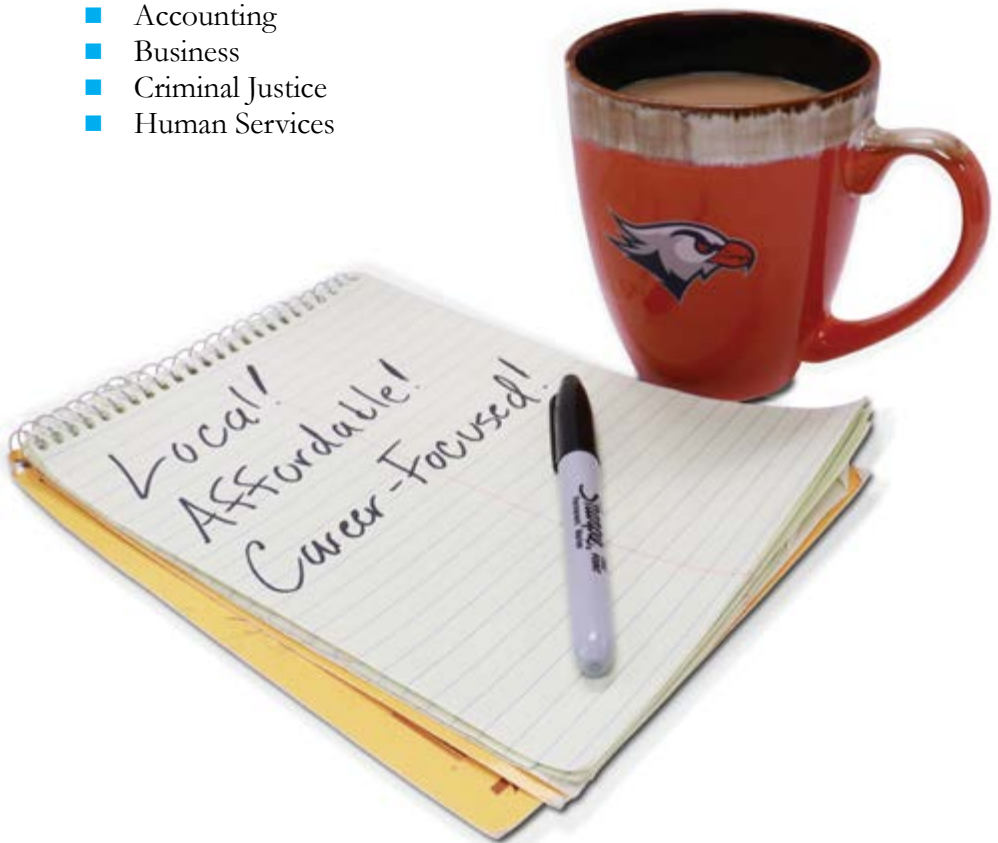
Working in the energy industry can be a physically demanding career, so you're encouraged to come back to any of Lackawanna's seven convenient locations for advanced degrees.
